Coach Sanderson is credited as having been the most dominant collegiate wrestler in NCAA history. His four individual national championships, a perfect 159-0 career record, and an Olympic Gold Medal (Athens 2002) have made him a national wrestling legend. In his first season with the Nittany Lions, Sanderson is leading the team back to national prominence.
